Then walk over to the second annual Yerba Buena Night at Yerba Buena Lane, Jessie Square and Yerba Buena Gardens Terrace for an extraordinary evening of live American Bluegrass, Middle-Eastern Percussion and other musical performances, contemporary ballet and Flamenco dancing, exciting new sculptures and the creation of a new mural on site.

“As the cultural hub of the city, Yerba Buena’s beautiful parks, museums, and restaurants are the perfect place to enjoy an evening under stars,” said Cathy Maupin, executive director of the Yerba Buena Community Benefit District (YBCBD), which is presenting the event. As home to 21 galleries and museums, Yerba Buena has the richest concentration of cultural institutions in San Francisco, as well as offering an enormous selection of food, drink, and entertainment.
