The Yerba Buena Community Benefit District (YBCBD) is pleased to issue the Community Benefit Fund Guidelines and Application.

Three types of grants are offered to nonprofits and resident organizations that seek to improve the quality of life in the Yerba Buena Neighborhood through the YBCBD Community Benefit Fund – full grants of up to \$25,000, and event sponsorships or mini-grants of up to \$5,000. If you're interested in applying, please carefully review the Fund Guidelines, Full Grant Proposal Application, and Mini-Grants/Event Sponsorship Application for further details. **You can download these documents at www.ycbcd.org.**

The YBCBD is a nonprofit community-based organization that works to improve the quality of life for residents and visitors in Yerba Buena by fostering a safe and secure community, enhancing environmental quality and beauty, and reinforcing the viability of the economic base. As part of our commitment to improving the Yerba Buena neighborhood, the YBCBD will award grant funds of up to \$78,500 this funding cycle and a total of up to \$157,000 in Fiscal Year 2020 to projects that benefit the neighborhood and support the goals of the YBCBD.

The YBCBD will be conducting a **Grantee Conference on Monday, July 22 from 10:00 to 11:00 a.m.** in YBCBD Conference Room, Suite 916 in the Hearst Building at 5 Third Street. This is essential for new applicants as our guidelines are typically refined each round. Past recipients are also encouraged to attend.

Applications for this cycle must be submitted to the YBCBD office by 5:00 p.m. on September 4, 2019. Applicants will be notified of funding decisions for mini-grants and event sponsorships by October 25, 2019 and full grants by November 15, 2019.
