

COVID-19 Update:

YBCBD to Maintain SFPD Bike Patrol, Suspend Cleaning Services

The [City of San Francisco](#) issued an unprecedented [Public Health Order](#) on March 16, 2020 requiring “that residents remain in place, with the only exception being for essential needs” in order to slow the spread of the Coronavirus 2019 Disease (COVID-19). That order is in effect from March 17 until April 7, 2020.

Maintaining the health of the YBCBD staff and teams that provide our services is a top priority and we have altered some of our services. Here are important updates and information.

- **San Francisco Police Department Patrol:** The SFPD bike patrol officer we fund will continue to patrol Yerba Buena. For emergencies, call 911.
- **YBCBD offices and meetings:** Our office is closed and our staff is working remotely. - **Cleaning & Community Guide Services:** We are suspending our cleaning and Community Guide services through April 7.
- **City Services will Continue:** Through April 7, if you have an urgent sidewalk or street cleaning issue, please call the City’s 311 service. Please note that the City stated that refuse collection will continue during this time by Recology and Public Works.
