The YBCBD is a nonprofit community-based organization that works to improve the quality of life for residents and visitors in Yerba Buena by fostering a safe and secure community, enhancing environmental quality and beauty, and reinforcing the viability of the economic base. As part of our commitment to improving the Yerba Buena neighborhood, the YBCBD will award grant funds of up to \$88,000 this funding cycle and a total of up to \$176,000 in Fiscal Year 2023/2024 to projects that benefit the neighborhood and support the goals of the YBCBD.
