Grants Available – Applications due April 1, 2025

Yerba Buena Partnership is a community benefit district and nonprofit organization that works to make the Yerba Buena neighborhood clean, safe, and welcoming for residents, employees, and visitors. In addition, the organization advocates for and funds projects that improve our neighborhood public spaces, and promotes Yerba Buena businesses and organizations.

As part of our commitment to improving the Yerba Buena neighborhood, a total amount of \$200,000 will be awarded this fall to projects that benefit the neighborhood and support the Yerba Buena Partnership's goals.

Grant Types

The Community Benefit Fund offers two types of grants to projects, programs, and events that seek to improve the quality of life in the Yerba Buena neighborhood – **mini-grants** from \$1,000 - \$5,000 and **full grants** up to \$25,000.
